


Landscape Design Assistance Program – Sample Base Map Instructions

To assist your Designer with the design consultation, we recommend that applicants draw a basic map of their property to scale on graph paper. Include existing fence lines, house location, plants/trees, and hardscape that will not change.

Using graph paper, draw a base map of your yard. The base map can include the following:

- An outline of the front of your home, walkways, driveway, sidewalk, property lines, fences, and other structures, indicating their placement on the property.
- Property orientation (a north arrow) in order to identify sun/shade patterns on your property.
- Draw the base map so that ¼ inch on the base map represents 1 foot in the real yard. Using the graph paper, use 1 square for every 1 foot.





Alternatively, use GoogleMaps to create a base map:

- 1. Locate your property on maps.google.com
- 2. Click "Layers" at the bottom left of the screen and choose the "Satellite" view



- 3. Center your property on the map
- 4. Screenshot and print the base map in black and white, making sure to include the scale in the bottom right of the screen
